You will receive \$100.00 of your housing deposit back at the end of your program as long as you leave your room in good, clean condition, pay your rent on time, and successfully complete your program. If you are traveling with a friend be sure the names are provided to your home country agent and United Work and Travel as soon as possible so we can try to room you together. Housing details will be sent to you prior to your departure from your home country.
